School Canteen and Breakfast Program

The Breakfast Program has fruit and toast from 8.30am.

The canteen is open for breakfast at 8.30am before school. It provides nutritious food and snacks at recess and lunch times at reasonable prices. Students are asked to order their lunch before school or at recess. We also have a mobile phone app Qkr where parents can order their childrens lunch. Our canteen is a great part of our school and provides a wonderful service for students.

Library

The school has an up-to-date, extensive collection of books, journals, CD, DVDs and newspapers. Our library has the latest data projection equipment, cameras and laptops which are available for students. Our library technicians are on duty to assist students' research queries and the use of computers.

Student Representative Council

The SRC council is made up of elected students from each class from Year 7 to 9. The students are elected by their own class to represent them. The SRC is involved in a range of activities such as promoting the school, fundraising for the school in their year, and discussing relevant issues and forwarding suggestions to the SEC. They learn about meeting procedures and how to be part of a team working toward a common goal.
